

UK&I Energy Policy Statement

This policy statement sets out our commitment to achieving best practice energy management standards across our organisation and applies to all colleagues and contractors in the UK and Ireland.

The OCS UK&I Group (being OCS UK&I Limited and its direct and indirect subsidiaries) is committed to leading by example; and delivering quality facility management services to our customers in a responsible and sustainable manner. OCS appreciates that energy use is integral to the provision of its services and as a result the Company is committed to the implementation and maintenance of a robust energy management system registered to the ISO 50001: 2018 (ISO 50001) standard. The system will be documented and communicated appropriately.

OCS UK&I's Board are committed to supporting the implementation and maintenance of the system and will ensure necessary resources are made available to achieve objectives and targets. A Management Representative has been designated and a supporting Energy Management Team established.

Effective energy management objectives, targets and programmes will be measurable, reviewed regularly and implemented in line with this policy and the Company's identified significant energy users. Progress will be monitored regularly using energy performance indicators. They will be formally reviewed annually during a management review.

OCS is committed to continually improving energy performance within its owned and leased assets including buildings and vehicles. The Company is committed to becoming carbon net zero for scope 1, 2 and 3 by 2040. OCS is also committed to procuring 100% renewable electricity for all UK&I offices and for all company vehicles to be electric or hybrid by 2034. The Company is committed to complying with all appropriate energy legislation and any other requirements, e.g. Codes of Practice.

Energy efficiency will be considered in the purchase of products, new equipment, and services and in the design of products or during renovation or modification of any buildings. Our suppliers shall be informed of this commitment.

This policy will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure its effectiveness, and to ensure continual improvement of the energy management system.
